

Getting a scholarship for a BA's Degree, How to access to the University of Jaén?

Direct Admission for:

Foreign students from all over the world holding a **European High-School Diploma** (British, German, French or other EU High-School) or **International High-School Diploma**.

Foreign students coming from **European Union educational systems** or educational systems of Andorra, China, Iceland, Norway, Switzerland, and Liechtenstein.

Foreign students with **partial studies** (at least 30 ECTS related to the degree which they want to get enrolled in) in any **official Spanish or foreign higher education system**.

Foreign students with **pre-university studies** comparable to a **Higher Level Technician of professional teaching**².

Steps for Admission:

1st Complete the online prescription process to a BA's Degree, according to the regulations of the UJA and the University Unique District of Andalusia.

2nd Complete the registration process at the University of Jaén, according to the procedure and regulatory deadlines.

Other Admission Processes for:

Foreign students with a **High-School Diploma** or equivalent from educational systems not mentioned above have to obtain the official recognition (homologation) and/or validation to the equivalent Spanish one through the Spanish Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports³ and pass the UJA admission criteria.

Steps for Admission:

1st If not coming from a EU educational system, pass the UJA admission criteria.

2nd Complete the online prescription process to a BA's Degree, according to the regulations of the UJA and the University Unique District of Andalusia.

3rd Complete the registration process at the University of Jaén, according to the procedure and regulatory deadlines.

Two modalities of Scholarships

Type A

Tuition fees waiver + Grant for Bachelor's and Master's studies

- 180 scholarships for Bachelor's¹ and 45 for Master's studies
- 100% of the tuition fees for the whole Bachelor's or Master's degree.
- A grant of €2,200 (Bachelor)/€3,000 (Master) per year and candidate (\$2,400/\$3,200 approx.).
- Free Spanish courses for non-Spanish speaking students.

Students should have a minimum GPA of 7 out of a scale of 10

Type B

Tuition fees waiver for Bachelor's studies

- 72 scholarships for Bachelor's studies
- 100% of the tuition fees for the whole Bachelor's degree.
- Free Spanish courses for non-Spanish speaking students.

Students should have a minimum GPA of 6.5 out of a scale of 10

¹ A number of 7 Scholarships for Bachelor's studies will be reserved for finalists of the Spanish School Olympic Games that will be held in Russia in April 2017.
